Digital skills shortages are becoming urgent. The UK's relatively low ranking in the global skills table highlights the need for the UK to update skill sets nationally

In the 1970s, the UK was sometimes referred to as the 'sick man of Europe' an unkind term, but it reflected the country's poor economic performance compared to the Continent. Fifty years later, the 70s moniker threatens to re-emerge, as the UK's digital skills shortage and sluggish economy hamper the country's potential.

The British economy grew just 0.1 percent in the first three months of this year; the little growth there was, was partly driven by the information and communications services industries, which
