





### **LOGGIN IN**

Once your learner form has been submitted, your details will be set up on the Academy site by the EDA training team. You will receive an email (see below) from the 'EDA Academy' directing you how to log in.

On your first login, you will be asked to change your password. Now is the time to note this down somewhere so that you do not forget it.


### VIEWING THE COURSES

Alternatively, you can view the courses by clicking on the '**Learn**' tab.




Then selecting 'Find learning' from the drop-down menu as seen below:





You will be directed to another page that will reflect all of the modules you are currently studying as seen below:



- The circled areas are the courses that I have been enrolled on to. The number of courses that you see will depend on the number of courses you have been enrolled on and could just be one or all twelve. There will be a progress bar under each course you are enrolled onto. If you do not see this under the title of your course, this means you are not enrolled onto the course.
- To start, or continue the course, simply click on the title. Your screen will now look like this:








### **SECTION 1**

- When you select them, another page will launch:




From here, you will need to **click this link**.



- Press start course and work your way through the content of this unit.




Once you have started this your page will like this:

Please remember at the end of each piece of learning you need to press **'Continue'** which will come up at the bottom of the screen as seen below:




Once you have completed the unit, the circle will be coloured orange with a white tick to show completion.
