# Setting the scene for product legislation

## UK Legislation:

- Construction Product Regulations 2013
- Electrical Equipment (Safety) Regulations 2016
- The General Product Safety Regulations 2005

## Construction Product Regulations 2013

- ✓ Compulsory Third Party Testing
- 📄 Declaration of Performance
- 🌲 EPDs

## Electrical Equipment (Safety) Regulations 2016

- 👉 Self declaration
- 📄 Declaration of Conformity



“Distributor” - means any person in the supply chain, other than the manufacturer or the importer, who makes electrical equipment available on the market

*Before* making electrical equipment available on the market, the *distributor* must verify that:

- the electrical equipment bears the CE or UKCA marking;
- is accompanied by the required documents;
- is accompanied by instructions and safety information;
- the manufacturer has complied with the requirements of regulation 8 (labelling of electrical equipment);
- the importer has complied with the requirements of regulation 18 (information identifying importer).

- ⚖️ Accountability for Online Marketplaces
- ⚡ Rapid updating of the regulation
